Hauppauge Library's General Rules and Expectations for 2017 Battle of the Books

For Teens Entering Grades 6-9/ Hauppauge Library cardholders only—strictly enforced by the Battle of the Books Administrators

- Books will be provided upon sign-up. (Please keep books in good condition. Do not mark them up.)
- If you decide to stop participating in the Battle, you must return the books directly to a Children's Librarian. (These aren't regular library books, so please <u>do not</u> return in the book drop or the circulation desk.)
- You must read all eight books by Monday, July 17. (The date of the Mock Battle.)
- Books will be read closely for detail, in order to remember trivia. This program is not about reading comprehension or opinions— it is purely a trivia competition.
- You will be competing for a spot on the final team of six. (Your information packets have the exact way to earn points, along with a lot of other important information. Please refer to it often and do not lose it.)
- You must arrive on time for the weekly meetings and stay until the end of the meeting in order to get attendance points. (See calendar in the information packet for dates/times.)
- Written quizzes are offered at the end of each meeting. Please account for this when arranging your ride home. (You may not get out exactly at 7:00pm if you choose to take a quiz.)
- Extra-credit verbal quizzes are being offered by appointment only. You must arrange the time and day directly with Miss Donna or Miss Catherine. If you make an appointment, we expect you to keep it or call us to cancel.
- We expect everyone to be respectful and courteous to each other. Coaches will take behavior into account during weekly meetings, as well as offsite events.

You must be available for the following three dates in order to participate:
Monday, July 17 (Mock Battle– at the Middle Country Library in Centereach. See separate permission slip.)
Saturday, August 12 (Battle at Stony Brook University. Exact time to be determined—it could be 8:00—11:30am or 12:30—4:00pm or 4:45—8:15pm)
Monday, August 14 (Playoffs at Stony Brook University. Exact time to be determined—usually it's 6:00pm. If we make the inals or win an award, this night is important.)
Top portion is for the patron. Bottom portion is for the library.

Why should you join Battle of the Books?

- You will read 8 fabulous books! (If you like reading AND you're good at remembering trivia, then this is the program for you!)
- Everyone gets to go to a "mock" battle and compete against other libraries! (Everyone gets a team T-shirt for this Mock Battle!)
 - Depending on your scores, you may get to compete at the county-wide battle at Stony Brook University in August! (The top 6 players only)
- You can use the books you read for the Battle also for the Summer Reading Club to earn raffle tickets. (Each book does double duty... you can't beat that!)
- There will be snacks and drinks at each of the meetings and we have a pizza party for all participants at the last meeting!

Please Note:

- You must have a Hauppauge Public Library card in order to join. (If you don't, check with your home library- they may have a team of their own.)
 - Deadline to join: Friday, June 9th
- Maximum # of participants at weekly meetings: 20

Please see a librarian for full details and a permission slip for your parent/guardian to sign listing all of the commitments required to join.

What is the final six?

The final six are the six Battle participants that make the "official" Battle of the Books team and get to participate in the countywide competition representing Hauppauge Public Library on Saturday, August 12th and Monday, August 14th.

How do I become one of the final six?

The final six will be the Battle of the Books participants with the most points.

Listed below are the ways you can earn points:

Attendance: 5 points per meeting (including Mock Battle)

*This is an easy way to earn points and an important way for the coaches to see the participants in action. It also helps to build the cohesiveness and spirit of the team members.

Character Fact Sheets: 1 point per character (maximum of 20

points per book) *This is a good way to solidify trivia facts for yourself and the best part is that you're in control of how many points you receive... the more effort you put in to it, the more points you earn!

Quizzes: 40 points per book (2 pts. per question/20 questions)

*This is just one of the ways the coaches can determine how well you remember trivia details from the books. If anyone needs to take a verbal quiz instead of a written one, please let us know- this can be arranged with no problem.

Extra Credit: One-On-One verbal trivia appointment with a coach 20 points per book (2 pts. per question/10 questions)

*Kind of like the written quizzes, with questions and answers, but instead the coach reads the question (only to you) and you have 5 seconds to answer out loud. (The same amount of time you get in the real Battle.) This is done by appointment so it's just you and the coach, not the whole group. It's a good way to practice your verbal skills and for you and the coaches to see your strengths for each book. Speak directly with the coaches to make each of your appointments.

What if I don't make the final six team?

If you don't make the final six, you still get to come have fun at all of our meetings and the pizza party. Plus, every participant gets a team T-shirt to wear to the Mock Battle. Not to mention, you get to read 8 great books and talk about them with your new Battle of the Books friends!

Via Local Roads

Take 347 East to Middle Country Rd. East (RT 25)
Go approximately 3 miles on Middle Country Rd until
you see Eastwood Blvd (across from Burger King.)
Make a left onto Eastwood Blvd. and continue 4/10
mile to MCPL- Centereach on the left.

Via the Expressway

Exit #62 North (Nicolls Road) off Long Island Expressway. Go North on Nicolls Road to Middle Country Road (Route 25). Take the exit ramp on your right for Smithtown (West). At the end of exit ramp, make left onto Route 25 West. Continue 6/10 mile to Eastwood Boulevard. Turn right at light (across from Burger King) and continue 4/10 mile to MCPL-Centereach on the left.
