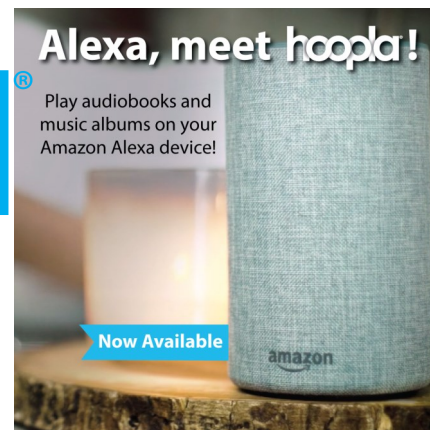

Play downloaded audiobooks and music albums on your Amazon Echo, Dot, Spot and Show.

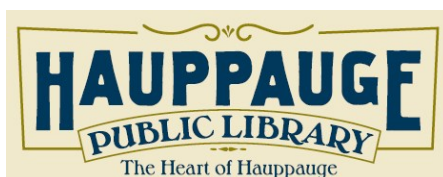


Getting Started

- **Add the hoopla skill to Alexa.** This can be done from your home computer OR mobile device.
 - **From a home computer:**
 - **Log in** to your **Amazon account**
 - Select **Alexa Skills** from the drop down menu next the **Search** bar
 - **Search** for **hoopla Digital**
 - Choose **Enable Skill**
 - **From a mobile device:**
 - **Download** the **Alexa app** from the App Store (iOS devices) or Google Play Store (Android devices)
 - Select **Skills & Games** from the menu
 - **Search** for **hoopla Digital**

Commands

- Requests to Alexa must start like this **“Alexa, ask hoopla . . .”** so that Alexa will know to get the information from hoopla, and not from Amazon. Here is a list of commands you can use:
 - **Alexa, ask hoopla** how many items I can borrow.
 - **Alexa, ask hoopla** how many items I currently have borrowed.
 - **Alexa, ask hoopla** for my library’s phone number.
 - **Alexa, ask hoopla** to list all the titles I have borrowed.
 - **Alexa, ask hoopla** to list my music.
 - **Alexa, ask hoopla** to list the music I currently have borrowed.
 - **Alexa, ask hoopla** to play my music.
 - **Alexa, ask hoopla** to list my audiobooks
 - **Alexa, ask hoopla** to list the audiobooks I currently have borrowed.
 - **Alexa, ask hoopla** to play my audiobooks.
