

2019 Pre-K and Children's SRC Instructions



Monday, July 1– Friday, August 16 (Ages Birth-entering Grade 5)

Sign up for the Summer Reading Club with a librarian (we'll give you a user name and password and write it below) or visit our website from home in order to create a profile with a user name and password of your choosing. **(If you do it at home, make sure to come in to the library to collect your sign-up goodie bag.)**

User Name: (first name last name no caps no spaces) _____

Password: **abc1234** (you can change this once you login the first time)

Here's how you sign up from home: (or you can do this part in person with a librarian)

- Go to (<http://hauppaugelibrary.org/>) and click on the icon that looks like this.  
- Click where it says, "Register Online Here" or "Don't have an account? Register now."
- **New this year:** You may sign up as an individual or have your parent sign you and your siblings up as a family account. Either way, fill out the rest of the information in the form. (Make sure to write down your username and password and put it in a safe place.) **IMPORTANT: If you are entering Kindergarten– Grade 5, choose the Kids Club, even if your age doesn't match the age range shown. If you are entering grades 6-12, choose the teen club, even if your age doesn't match the age range shown.**

Here's how you record your books and earn prizes:

- Read! (That's the fun part!) Every time you finish a book, record it on your paper reading record.
- From July 1st– August 16th, come in once a week for your prize. (There will be 7 weeks of prizes. They are changed out every Monday, but you can collect your prize any day of the week. If you miss a week, we will give you what you missed as long as supplies last.)
- When you come in, a teen volunteer will record your name and the number of books you've read. You will then get a chance to tell them something about one of the books you've read.

You may read as much as you wish, but this year we have a completion challenge.

Pre-K: Each book= 20 points/ 1000 points (50 books) = completion

Children: Each book= 50 points/ 1000 points (20 books) = completion

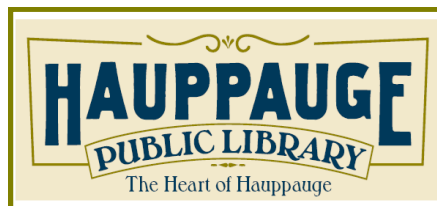
If you choose to log your books online as well, you can do a whole bunch of neat things. Go to our website, click on the Summer Reading Club icon, and enter your username and password.

- To record a book title, click "Enter Activity", enter the date (you may choose today's date or dates in the past), then enter the title and author. You can even add a book review or star rating, if you'd like. (All book reviews will be read by a staff member before displaying on the website.)

You can also do a number of fun, extra things:

- ⇒ Create an avatar design for your online account
- ⇒ See suggested reading lists
- ⇒ Play space-themed games
- ⇒ Complete space-themed missions

The more you record your reading activity, the more games and missions you'll unlock!



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
