



Bookmarks for Liberation Library

Teen Volunteers Grades 6-12

Liberation Library is a volunteer run organization that provides books to youth in prison to encourage imagination, self-determination and a connection to the outside world. They try to include a hand-made bookmark with every book they provide to a young person. That's where they can use our help.

How to complete this project:

Using cardstock paper (heavier paper than regular printer paper) create designs that promote the act of reading and/or positive phrases or messages. (Please don't share any personal information on your bookmarks.) Bookmarks can be hand-made (using pen, pencil, crayons, markers) or computer-designed and then printed out. Bookmarks must not include stickers, tape, or glue.

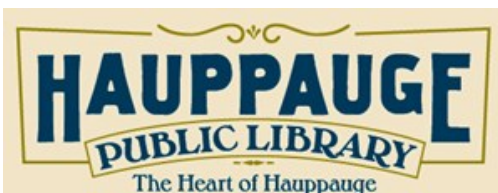
Take one picture of your finished bookmarks and email it as an attachment to the following address:

help@hauppaugelibrary.org with the subject line: Volunteer Liberation Library. In the body of the email, include your full name, phone number, and grade level. Within 5 days, you will receive notification of your community service.

Teens will receive one (1) hour of community service for four (4) original bookmarks. Maximum credit for this project is three (3) hours, which equals twelve (12) bookmarks, per newsletter season: Winter (Dec/Jan/Feb); Spring (Mar/Apr/May); Summer (Jun/Jul/Aug); Fall (Sept/Oct/Nov).
