

Change Someone's Day

A Volunteer Opportunity for Teens in Grades 6-12



Practice random acts of kindness by leaving quarters at places where people can really use it: vending machines in a hospital, on the washer/dryer at a laundromat, or on a parking meter on a busy street. You can *change* someone's day for the better with this simple gesture.

How to complete this project:

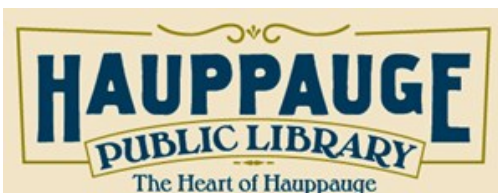
Print out a template for one of the locations you wish to leave your quarters (see separate flyer for templates) or make your own version. Get creative! Adhere your quarters to the paper with tape, and put the whole thing in a clear Ziplock bag. Go to the location of your choosing and tape the bag to the appropriate place.

How to get community service:

Teens will receive one (1) hour of community service for three (3) "Change Someone's Day" bags put out into the world. Maximum credit for this project is two (2) hours, which equals six (6) bags, per newsletter season: Winter (Dec/Jan/Feb); Spring (Mar/Apr/May); Summer (Jun/Jul/Aug); Fall (Sept/Oct/Nov).

In order to receive community service, you must take a picture of your finished "Change Someone's Day" bag at the location(s) you chose and email it as an attachment to: help@hauppaugelibrary.org with the subject line: Volunteer Change Someone's Day.

Along with the picture, include in the body of the email: your full name, phone number, and grade level. Within 5 days, you will receive notification of your community service.
