A volunteer opportunity for teens in grades 6-12

You know how Google does their daily Google doodles? Well, think of that, but with the word Hauppauge instead. We need you to create some original artwork that we will use to help decorate our walls in the Teen area of the Library.

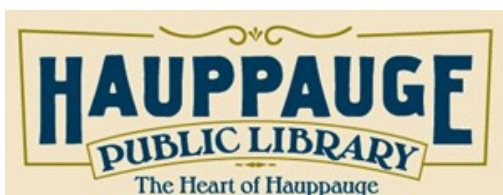
## How to complete this project:

- All designs must have the word Hauppauge clearly visible and should go with the theme of the town of Hauppauge in general or Hauppauge Public Library specifically. How you interpret that theme is up to you!
- You can create your design by hand, using any medium you'd like (paint, watercolor, pencil, crayons, etc.) It must fit on an 8.5 X 11 size paper, so you can scan the image. (The library has a scanner you can use, free of charge.)
- Or you can create your design on the computer, using any program or software you'd like (Word, Publisher, SketchUp, Canva, or any other designing software.)
- Or you can create your design using photography and/or Photoshop.
- All drawings/images must be original. (Please don't copy and paste other people's work, unless that image is licensed for "creative commons" use.) Your design can be in color or black and white.

## How to get credit:

Save a copy of your work as a JPEG and email it as an attachment to the following address: [help@hauppaugelibrary.org](mailto:help@hauppaugelibrary.org) with the subject line: Volunteer Hauppauge Art Doodle. In the body of the email, include your full name, phone number, and grade level. Within approximately 5 days, you will receive notification of your community service credit.

Disclaimer: Teens will receive one (1) hour of community service for one Art Doodle. Maximum credit for this project is one (1) hour, which equals one (1) Art Doodle, per newsletter season: Winter (Dec/Jan/Feb); Spring (Mar/Apr/ May); Summer (Jun/Jul/Aug); Fall (Sept/Oct/Nov).
