Kathleen Brett, Head of Guest Services reported on starting work on a campaign to increase cardholders at our library. She has updated our welcome email. We are adding Adventureland tickets for sale at the library for \$27.50 which includes all the rides and

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free parking. She organized a meeting on work ergonomics for staff. She also reported on her new role as art gallery coordinator. The CEO shared a recent conversation he had with staff about enforcing the Maintenance of Public Order and Rules of Conduct at the Library policies. The Library is experiencing some new behavior at the library and staff are being asked to confront new conditions they have not been asked to before. The CEO shared updates on expected PILOT income, deadlines for Sexual Harassment Prevention training, recent meetings with the Parks Department and State of the Town address, Action Plan. Friends meeting and plans for the summer reading program and National Library Week. The CEO shared the plans for new software licenses for our website, app, room booking, event sign ups and more.

## RESOLUTION APPROVING 2024-2025 BUDGET IN EXCESS OF STATE TAX CAP

WHEREAS, the adoption of the 2024 – 2025 budget for the Hauppauge Public Library (the "Library") requires a tax levy increase that exceeds the tax cap imposed by State law as outlined in General Municipal Law ("GML") §3-c, adopted in 2011;

**WHEREAS**, GML §3-c expressly permits the Library Board of Trustees to override the tax levy limit by a resolution approved by a vote of sixty percent of qualified Board Trustees;

**WHEREAS,** by unanimous resolution of the Library Board of Trustees dated January 17, 2024, the Board resolved to present a budget to the voters for approval that exceeds the tax levy limit for the 2024—2025 fiscal year;

**RESOLVED**, that the Board of Trustees of the Hauppauge Public Library does hereby vote to, and approve to, exceed the tax levy limit for the 2024 - 2025 fiscal year by at least sixty percent of the Board of Trustees, as required by State law.
